A New Vision for Crash Repair

Thatcham and the BSI will be working in partnership to develop and implement, through industry wide consultation, a Publicly Available Specification and Kitemark certification scheme which will drive and recognise quality standards within UK crash repair.

By consulting closely with leading industry organisations, Thatcham and BSI will deliver a workable specification and certification scheme designed by and for those engaged in crash repair.
